

Year 7 Catch up Funding Plan

In 2015/16 Droylsden Academy received £14500 for the 29 students who did not achieve level 4 (LPA) in Key Stage tests in English and/or Mathematics in 2014. The plan to spend this funding is as follows:

Partial payment for 'Thinking Reading' – Training and resources	£2000
Purchase of resources and additional costs to support the delivery of Catch up Lesson 6 for Year 7 and 8 students and additional intervention resources	£2000
Partial Salary of Curriculum Tutor Numeracy	£5425
Partial Salary of Curriculum Tutor Literacy	£5425
Total	£14850

In 2015 Lesson 6 was introduced for Year 7 catch up students. These have been continued into 2016. These are bi-weekly compulsory lessons that are in addition to the Core Maths and English lessons that the students receive. To further support some of the very LPA students a Teaching Assistant will be given extra responsibility to plan and deliver intensive Literacy and Numeracy sessions to very small groups to build confidence and build progress. (Key Skills). Further appointments will be made for high quality, well trained Curriculum Tutors in Maths (Numeracy) and English (Literacy)

The impact of this spending will be reported following data collection in July 2017.
