Charities Act 2011 Automatic Disqualification Rules

There are rules which disqualify certain people from being a trustee of a charity. Being disqualified means that a person can't take on, or stay in, a charity trustee position – even on an interim basis, unless the Charity Commission has removed (or 'waived') the disqualification. Reasons for automatic disqualification include:

A Unspent convictions for specific offences:

1. Unspent conviction for an offence involving dishonesty or deception
2. Unspent conviction for specified terrorism offences
3. Unspent conviction for a specified money laundering offence
4. Unspent conviction for specified bribery offences
5. Unspent conviction for the offence of contravening a Charity Commission Order or Direction
6. Unspent conviction for offences of misconduct in public office, perjury, or perverting the course of justice
7. Unspent convictions for aiding, attempting or abetting the above offences

B Other legal disqualifying reasons – non-financial

8. Being on the sex offenders register
9. Unspent sanction for contempt of Court
10. Disobeying a Charity Commission Order
11. Being a designated person (under specific anti-terrorist legislation)
12. Being a person who has been removed from a relevant office
13. Director disqualification

C Other legal disqualifying reasons – financial

14. Insolvency.
